

## Get Your FYP Funded through National Grassroots ICT Research Initiative (NGIRI)

The program aims to assist final year undergraduate students of ICT related disciplines studying in the Institutions by providing them financial assistance for developing prototypes / working models of their Final Year Projects (FYP) in order to increase creativity, innovation and hands on engineering and development skills.

The Program has been divided into two phases:

### **Phase – I: (Funding of FYP)**

FYP are selected for funding with following financial breakup:

Equipment: Maximum up to Rs. 70,000/-

Miscellaneous: Maximum up to Rs. 10,000/-

### **Phase-II: (National Championship)**

Selected FYP from participating institutions will be invited to compete for the National Championship. Winners will be awarded following prizes:

#### **National Champion**

Project Team (up to 4 Students) Cash Prize of Rs: 400,000

Project Supervisor Cash Prize of Rs: 100,000

#### **First Runner Up**

Project Team (up to 4 Students) Cash Prize of Rs: 300,000

Project Supervisor Cash Prize of Rs: 75,000

#### **Second Runner Up**

Project Team (up to 4 Students) Cash Prize of Rs: 200,000

Project Supervisor Cash Prize of Rs: 50,000

## Eligibility criteria:

- **Eligibility Criteria for Participation of Institutions:**

All Institutions are eligible to participate in the Program. Constituent Campus/college of Universities/DAI shall be treated as a separate institution for the purpose of subject Program.

- **Eligibility Criteria for Participation of Students:**

1. Students must be studying in final year (4<sup>th</sup> academic year) of their undergraduate degree program of the Institutions.
2. Students must have enrolled in ICT related undergraduate degree programs which includes but not limited to followings:
  - Electrical Engineering
  - Electronic Engineering
  - Mechatronic Engineering
  - Computer System Engineering
  - Software Engineering
  - Computer Science
  - Information Technology
  - Avionics Engineering
  - Bio-Informatics

## **Step 2: Signup**

(FYP team leader should signup and must follow the given instructions. FYP supervisor may help them in the process)

General Instructions for signup

1. Fill the Application Form properly with complete and correct information / answers.
2. All fields marked with \* are mandatory.
3. Enter your CNIC No. carefully without hyphen
4. All the emails will be generated on the email provided by the user on the time of Signup.
5. Before signing up, decide who will be Team Lead and how many Team Members along with their Names & CNIC will be in your FYP. There can be maximum up to 4 team members in one FYP including Team Lead. Information related with Team Members will not be altered once submitted.
6. Use your OWN email address, CNIC and mobile number for registration process, as the provided data will be used for further processing. In case of incorrect data or same email address used on behalf of other students may lead to cancellation of registration process.
7. Please check your Junk folder in case no email received.
8. DO NOT leave any field blank, otherwise your application shall be rejected by the online system.

9. Students experiencing issues or face any difficulty in filling the online application form, are advised to contact Focal Person of their institution or email at [ngiri@ignite.org.pk](mailto:ngiri@ignite.org.pk)
10. Students are advised to contact their respective university focal person in case of delay in approval.
11. Ignite will not be responsible for disqualification of those students who have not given their information accordingly.
12. Use good Internet, with Recommended Browsers (chrome, firefox, Microsoft edge) for proper submission to avoid any issue.

**Step 3:** After this the related information shall be provided by the team leader regarding their FYP. All this information should be verified by the FYP supervisor e.g. Milestones, budget and working of project, start date, end date of project etc.

After completion the final working project will be called for a nationwide competition along the supervisor and team members.
